

Camping Codex

- 1 Camp & park only where it is allowed.
- 2 Leave places cleaner than you found them.
- 3 Respect your fellow human beings - campers and residents alike..
- 4 Respect nature and live in harmony with it.
- 5 Going to the toilet in nature: whether big or small, keep the environment clean. Toilet paper and the contents of (chemical) toilets do not belong in nature.
- 6 Only light open fires in designated areas, pay attention to forest fire levels and nature conservation areas.
- 7 Keep a respectful distance from your fellow campers on pitches or ask if you can stand next to them.
- 8 Be kind, positive and don't judge others.
- 9 Keep your dog in sight and on a lead. Pick up your dog's droppings and dispose of them in a garbage can - not in a bag in the woods.
- 10 Appreciate the community: help other campers when needed and share resources such as firewood or camping equipment when possible.
